#### 2010 AGM

We held our Annual General Meeting for 2010 on December 3<sup>rd</sup>. We discussed what happened in 2010, our plans for 2011, elected new board executive, ate some yummy foods, handed out our year-end awards and just generally had a good horsie time.

We also had a great presentation from Liz Spangler, showing what fun she got up to at some of the bigger events she went to in the US and Canada, which was very neat to see and hear about.

So! That brings us to our plans for this year!

# **Eventing101 Clinics**

We're starting off our year with our Eventing101 clinics again. We will hold our first clinic April 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> at the Winsloe Equestrian Centre. A little later start this year, but that's just the way things go sometimes I guess. This also gives everyone more time to get their ponies in shape! I know mine aren't right now. We hope to hold a second clinic in early May, tentatively at the Strathgartney Equine Park.

### **Big Plans!**

We've come up with some big goals for 2011. Starting off with making and painting new Cross-Country flags and numbers. A lot of the old flags were broken and just getting too small to use, and the numbers getting rather banged up as well. So we had a flag & number painting day in January, another on, February 20<sup>th</sup>. We're not done yet so will likely have two or three more painting days. Come out and help if you're free, it's not hard work, just slapping some paint on pieces of wood. Wear clothes you wont mind getting paint on (and maybe gloves if you don't want paint on your hands, as it's oil paint). and bring a snack to share with everyone.

This year we also want to add another level to our competitions. We've had lots of feedback that the gap from Pre-Entry (18") to Entry (2'9") was just too big, and consequently a lot of riders were getting stuck in Pre-Entry, just not quite ready to make the leap up. So to bridge the gap, this year we are adding PeeWee. PeeWee will be what Pre-Entry used to be, basically logs on the ground for Cross-country and cross-rails/small verticals for Stadium. Pre-Entry measurements will be moved up so that jump heights in Cross-country and Stadium will be 2'3" max. So we will have five levels, PeeWee(18"), Pre-Entry(2'3"), Entry(2'9"), Pre-Training(3') and Training(3'3").

Making these upgrades will obviously be a large amount of work, so please come help us on our work days so everything is ready to go by show day. We will hold our annual Clean-up/Jump Building day on May 21and will be doing a lot of the work that day, but will likely have some other work days at the park prior to that date to get a head start on things before show season starts.

We are also working on a couple more exciting clinics this year, with Ian Roberts and Kyle Carter. We're still working on the details and nothing is confirmed yet, but stay tuned!

Our schooling event is back this year, being held on the Victoria Day, Monday, May 23. Once again this year, if you come help out for an hour or more on the May 21<sup>st</sup> Clean-Up Day, you'll get a discount off your entry fee for the schooling show!

## 2011 Memberships

Memberships for 2011 are due, so get them in soon. Like last year, in order to ride in events put on by Horse Trials PEI, you will need an Island Horse Council membership. And in order to ride HTPEI events that are sanctioned by Equine Canada, you will need an EC Sport License as well as join Eventing Canada. Equine Canada memberships are due by the end of March to avoid late fees. IHC memberships were due first of January, and HTPEI memberships are due now. The form is on our website. Being a member of HTPEI gives you lower entry fees for HTPEI clinics and shows as well as makes you eligible for our year end awards.
