Entries

Cheques must be dated for the due date (Thursday, May 15th). Please make cheques payable to <u>Horse Trials PEI</u>. Competitors must have PSO insurance (Island Horse Council/NSEF/NBEA etc) Off-Island riders please send photocopies of your PSO and Horse Trials membership cards with your entry.

Fees

Eventing Fees: \$40/division for Horse Trials/Pony Club members, \$60 for non-members. \$75 for two divisions for members, \$95 for two divisions for non-members. \$20/phase for Hor Concours entries.

Dressage Fees: \$20/test

Late Fee: \$20 for all entries received after Thursday, May 15th, regardless of when you mailed it.

Dressage Tests

All **Eventing Dressage** tests are the 2011 Eventing Tests: (www.equinecanada.ca/eventing and click Dressage Tests on left then "2011 National Dressage Tests".)

All **Dressage** tests are the Dressage Canada National tests (www.equinecanada.ca/dressage and click "National Tests" and then "Tests and Arena Diagrams - FOR REVIEW ONLY")

Prizes

Ribbons to 6th place. Classes will be split into Junior and Senior for placings if entries warrant. There will be a break after the Dressage division to hand out ribbons to those doing Dressage Canada tests only.

Scratches and Refunds

In order to help us run our competition effectively, please be courteous and notify the show organizer **before** competition entry deadline if you must scratch. If you are unable to compete due to a horse's or rider's illness or injury, and have scratched as described above, entry fees will be refunded in full. Scratches after the entry deadline but 24 hours before show start, due to illness or injury will only be refunded 50%. Scratches without 24hours notice to show organizers will not be refunded.

Dress

Show attire is recommended, but not mandatory. For new riders who may not yet have show attire, clean and neat attire will be accepted. In case of extreme weather (hot or rainy), adjustments may be made and competitors will be informed on the day of the show. Helmets and proper footwear (tall riding boots or paddock boots with chaps) are required. A safety vest is **required** for Cross-country pace phase. Some vests will be available for borrowing if you do not own a vest.

General Rules

Protective headgear **must be worn** by any person when mounted anywhere on the show grounds.

Every division/test offered is covered by the rules and specifications of Equine Canada. Please be familiar with the rules, it is your responsibility to know the rules. Judge's decisions are final.

Competition numbers must be worn and visible in schooling rings and on the grounds as well as in the competition ring.

Eventing - Special Rules

A horse/rider combination can compete in two consecutive Eventing divisions only. You may not enter the same division twice unless you ride two different horses in it. Two different riders may ride the same horse, but any horse cannot compete in more than two divisions per show. Test callers may be used if desired but must be arranged by the competitor. All tests will be ridden in 20 metre x 40 metre ring.

Hors Concours

Hors concours entries will be allowed, for single phases only. You may not enter more than three single phases as hors concours. If you enter two regular divisions, you may not ride any hors concours phases. Hors concours entries will be judged, however no prizes or placings will be given. Cost is \$20/single phase.

Stadium Jumping Phase

Listed heights are the *maximum* height that the course will be set to. Degree of course difficulty will be appropriate to the level. Note that these shows are meant to be a schooling type and courses will be set with this in mind.

Pace Phase

This phase is designed to help competitors learn and practice their Cross country pacing skills. You will be judged on your ability to complete the course closest to the time allowed. Time penalties will be given out as per normal XC rules. You will be allowed to complete the pace phase twice and we will keep the best time for each rider. There will be no more than 4 cross-country type jumps on course. You can choose to not jump the jumps, but you will be penaltized 5 penalty points per jump omitted. Safety vests are required for this phase. There will be some vests available for use if you do not own a vest. Terrain: Rolling hills, open fields and wooded trails with excellent grass footing.

Dressage Rules

No horse may be entered in more than two divisions and these divisions must be consecutive. Riders may enter up to four tests. Dressage awards will be given at the conclusion of the Dressage Canada and Eventing Dressage tests. Anyone not present at the awards presentation without permission from the show Secretary forfeits his/her prize. All tests will be ridden in 20 metre x 60 metre ring. Test callers are permitted, but must be arranged by the rider.

Format

Dressage Canada tests will go first, Eventing Canada tests will begin after DC tests are completed and the dressage ring is changed to the smaller ring. Dressage Canada test awards will be handed out after all dressage tests have been completed. Eventing tests will begin at PeeWee and go up to Prelim. Stadium will follow Dressage and Cross-country will follow Stadium

Ride Times

Ride times will be available Saturday, May 17^{th} , at the Cross-country building day at Strathgartney Equine Park, or from the Deborah (eventingbee@hotmail.com ~ 902-620-1309) and will be posted on HTPEI's Facebook page and www.horsetrialspei.ca . If you include your e-mail address on the entry form, ride times will also be e-mailed to you. It is your responsibility to find out your ride times and be on time for it.

Stabling

No onsite stabling. Competitors must arrange their own stabling.
