Format:

Friday afternoon/evening: Semi Private (1hr) Dressage OR a mix of Flat/Jumping Lessons as per request. *LIMITED SPACE* contact Deborah Smith about availability **before** sending entry.

Saturday: Gymnastics & Jumping Courses

Saturday Night – Potluck BBQ at Liz Spangler's (452 Clyde Road, Hazel Grove). Informal Talk, Q & A and with David. BYOB and a snack.

Sunday: Cross Country Jumping

No previous Eventing experience is necessary; however, you and your horse/pony should be comfortable jumping cross rails and confident riding in an open field if you plan to do Cross-country. The clinic will be three days. You may ride only one or two days, or all three.

This is an excellent clinic for all horse/rider levels, and especially so if you are not sure at what level you are ready to compete.

Riders will receive a 2 hour group lesson each day (except 1 hour Friday). The information provided on the application form will be used to divide participants into groups of similar background and ability.

Your group composition and ride times will be available Thursday, June 11th, on our Facebook page and website. If you include an email address on the entry form, ride times will be emailed to you. It is your responsibility to know and be on time for your scheduled ride.

Refunds:

Refunds will be given until June 6th with doctor/vet certificate only. No refunds will be given after June 6th! Horse/Rider Substitutions will be allowed, must give at least 24 hours notice.
