# **Horse Trials PEI Derby**

### **Entries**

MAIL: Cheques must be dated for no later than due date (Wednesday, June 14<sup>th</sup>). Make cheques payable to *Horse* 

Trials PEI.

**ONLINE:** Email entry form and pay by e-transfer to: horsetrialspei@gmail.com

Entry forms must be fully completed and signed. **Competitors must have PSO insurance (Island Horse Council/NSEF/NBEA etc)** Off-Island riders please send photocopies of your PSO and Horse Trials membership cards with entry.

#### **Fees**

**Division Fees:** \$40/division for Horse Trials members, \$60 for non-members.

Class Fees: \$15 per class (members), \$20 (non-members).

Late Fee: \$25 for all entries received after Wednesday, June 14th, regardless of when you mailed it.

#### **Prizes**

Ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> place for Derby classes. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons for each Division. Additional Prizes.

## **Scratches and Refunds**

In order to help us run our competition effectively, please be courteous and notify the show organizer **before** competition entry deadline if you must scratch. If you are unable to compete due to a horse's or rider's illness or injury, and have scratched as described above, entry fees will be refunded in full. Scratches after the entry deadline but 24 hours before show start, due to illness or injury will only be refunded 50%. Scratches without 24hours notice to show organizers will not be refunded.

### **Dress**

Show attire is recommended, but not mandatory. For new riders who may not yet have show attire, clean and neat attire will be accepted. In case of extreme weather (hot or rainy), adjustments may be made and competitors will be informed on the day of the show. Helmets and proper footwear (tall riding boots or paddock boots with chaps) are required. A safety vest is required for Field Derby phase. Some vests will be available for borrowing if you do not own a vest.

### **General Rules**

Protective headgear must be worn by any person when mounted anywhere on the show grounds.

Every division/class offered is covered by the rules and specifications of Equine Canada. Please be familiar with the rules, it is your responsibility to know the rules. Judge's decisions are final.

Competition numbers must be worn and visible in schooling rings and on the grounds as well as in the competition ring.

# **Derby Scoring**

Derby classes will be "Match the Clock" or optimum time classes. They are designed to help developing riders learn the skill of riding a course at the posted speed, rather than with the fastest time. Competitors with equal faults will be placed according to how close their time is to the optimum time, which is based on the course being ridden at the posted speed.

**Field Derby:** Time penalties will be given out as per normal XC rules. Refusals at fences in the cross-country field will be scored 20 for the first, 40 for the second, 60 for the third. After the third refusal riders should continue on to the next jump without elimination. Knockdowns at Stadium type jumps will be scored 4 faults.

Warm up Round and Arena Derby: 1 penalty per second under the optimum time. No penalties for coming in between the Optimum Time and Time Allowed (4 seconds over the Optimum Time). There will be .4 penalties per second over the Time Allowed. Refusals at fences in the ring will be scored 4 faults for first, 8 for second, 16 for the third, then move on to next jump. Knockdowns 4 faults. Show committee reserves the right to eliminate/retire a horse/rider if they deem the ride is dangerous. Falls will result in elimination from that class.

**Safety vests are required for the Field Derby class.** There will be some vests available for use if you do not own a vest. Cross-Country field Terrain: Rolling hills, open fields and wooded trails with excellent grass footing.

# **Class Descriptions**

### Warm up Round

Warm up rounds will take place in the sand ring comprising of mainly hunter/jumper type Show Jumps but may include a few natural obstacles (straw fill, natural rails, etc).

### **Arena Derby**

Listed heights are the *maximum* height that the course will be set to. Degree of course difficulty will be appropriate to the level. Note that this show is meant to be a schooling type show and courses will be set with this in mind, jumps will not all be set at max. height. This class will take place in the sand arena and will be a course of 6-8 hunter/jumper type jumps and 2 simple Cross-Country portable type jumps.

# **Field Derby**

This class is designed to help introduce competitors to Cross-Country. This class will be a combination of cross-country jumps and show jumps. The class will start in the sand arena over a few show jumps, riders will continue out through the gate onto the Cross-country field for another 8-10 jumps, over a combination of cross-country and show jumps.

#### **Ride Times**

Ride times will be available Friday, June 16<sup>th</sup>, and will be posted on HTPEI's Facebook page and www.horsetrialspei.ca. If you include your e-mail address on the entry form, ride times will also be e-mailed to you. It is your responsibility to find out your ride times and to be on time for it. Show will not wait for you.


