CLINICIAN

Ruth Allum is the head coach and trainer at Oakhurst Farm. Ruth is committed to the total physical and mental preparation of both the rider and the horse. She combines her real life experiences as an Eventer with formal training as an Equestrian Canada certified High Performance – Eventing Coach. During her more than 20 years as a coach, Ruth has taken students from beginner levels to high levels of international competition. Whether her students are competing at the Pre-Entry or Advanced level, they still receive the benefit of Ruth's careful attention to detail in riding, conditioning, and building a strong horse and rider team.

Ruth has coached horse & rider teams to the Provincial Championships, the North American Young Rider Championships, the Canadian Eventing National Talent Squad as well as to a place on the Canadian Eventing Team Long List. She is also an Equine Canada Rider Level 1-10 Evaluator and an Equine Canada Rider Level Evaluator Mentor. Ruth is also an EC Certified Coach Developer – Evaluator for new coaches. Nationally, Ruth is proud to have been elected as Chair of the Canadian Eventing Committee and named to the Equestrian Canada National Coaching Technical Committee – representing Certified Equestrian – Eventing Coaches at the national level.

FORMAT

No previous Eventing experience is necessary. Riders will receive a 1.5 hour group lesson Friday and Saturday. Sunday will be a schooling show with coaching given throughout by Ruth. Riders will ride their dressage test in the morning, then receive feedback and coaching from Ruth for a re-ride. A jumping round will happen in the afternoon in the same format, an initial round followed by feedback and coaching through a second round. The information provided on the application form will be used to divide participants into groups of similar background and ability. No Refunds without Vet or Doctors note. Preference will be given to riders enrolled in the IHC EAD Program.

There will be an Island Horse Council Equestrian Athlete Development classroom session Saturday, approximately 4pm-7pm. This session is an additional \$25 UNLESS you are enrolled in the IHC EAD Program; there is no fee for EAD Program members. Please see IHC Website/Facebook for details.
