### Fees

\$60/division for Horse Trials members, \$70 for non-members.

**IF entering Two Divisions, fees are:** \$80 for two divisions for members, \$100 for two divisions for non-members.

**Dressage only:** \$40 for the first test, and \$20 each for any additional tests. Late Fee: \$20 late fee for entries received after Wednesday, May 18<sup>th</sup>. Note: Entries will not be accepted after Thursday, May 19<sup>th</sup>, 8pm.

### Prizes

Ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> place. Classes will be split into Junior and Senior for placings if entries warrant.

### Scratches and Refunds

In order to help us run our competition effectively, please be courteous and notify the show organizer **before** competition entry deadline if you must scratch. If you are unable to compete due to a horse's or rider's illness or injury, and have scratched as described above, entry fees will be refunded in full.

Scratches after the entry deadline but 24 hours before show start, due to illness or injury will be refunded 50%. Scratches without 24hours notice to show organizers will not be refunded without doctor/vet note.

### Dress

Show attire is recommended, but not mandatory. For new riders who may not yet have show attire, clean and neat attire will be accepted. In case of extreme weather (hot or rainy), adjustments may be made and competitors will be informed on the day of the show. Helmets and proper footwear (tall riding boots or paddock boots with chaps) are required. A safety vest is **required** for Cross-country phase.

## General Rules

Protective headgear **must be worn** by any person when mounted anywhere on the show grounds. Every division/test offered is covered by the rules and specifications of Equestrian Canada. Please be familiar with the rules, it is your responsibility to know the rules. Judge's decisions are final. Competition numbers must be worn and visible in schooling rings and on the grounds as well as in the competition ring.

## Special Rules

A horse/rider combination can compete in two consecutive Eventing divisions only. You may not enter the same division twice unless you ride two different horses in it. Two different riders may ride the same horse, but any horse cannot compete in more than two divisions per show. Test callers may be used if desired but must be arranged by the competitor. All eventing tests will be ridden in 20 meter x 40 meter ring.

## Derby

The derby is designed to help introduce competitors to Cross-Country. It will be a combination of cross country jumps and show jumps. The class will start in the sand arena over 4-6 show jumps, riders will continue out through the gate onto the Cross-country field for another 8-10 jumps, over a combination of cross-country and show jumps.

## Derby Scoring

**Derby:** Time penalties will be given out as per normal XC rules. Refusals at fences in the cross-country field and in the arena will be scored 20 for the first, 40 for the second, 100 for the third. After the third refusal riders should continue on to the next jump without elimination. Knockdowns of Stadium type jumps will be scored 4 faults. **Safety vests are required for the Derby class.** There may be some vests available for use if you do not own a vest. Cross-Country field Terrain: Rolling hills, open fields and wooded trails with excellent grass footing.

Ride times will be available Friday, May 20th<sup>d</sup>, and will be posted on HTPeI's Facebook page and [www.horsetrialspei.ca](http://www.horsetrialspei.ca) **It is your responsibility to find out your ride times and to be on time for it.**

**ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY**

**WARNING: THIS AGREEMENT WILL AFFECT YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS. READ IT CAREFULLY!**

**Each participant or Parent/Guardian of a minor participant Must Read and Understand this Waiver Before Participating in Equine Activities**

The following waiver of all claims, release from all liability, assumption of all risks, agreement not to sue and other terms of this agreement are entered into by me (the Participant) with and for the benefit of: Horse Trials PEL, its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, business operators, agents and site property owners or lessees (collectively the "Host"). Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, "Equine Activities" includes but is not limited to, competitions, tournaments organized and/or operated by the "Host", riding instruction, coaching and training provided by the "Host" to the Participant.

**Initial Each Item below after Reading and Understanding each item:**

1. I am aware that there are inherent dangers, hazards and risks (collectively "Risks") associated with "Equine Activities" and injuries resulting from these "Risks" are a common occurrence. I am aware that the "Risks" of "Equine Activities" mean those dangerous conditions which are an integral part of "Equine Activities", including but not limited to:

- a) the propensity of any equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to persons on or around them and to potentially collide with, bite or kick other animals, people or objects;
- b) the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement, tremors, vibrations, unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals and hazards such as subsurface objects;
- c) the potential for other participants to behave in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to themselves or others, including failing to act within their abilities to maintain control over an equine.
- d) the potential of natural or man-made hazards being present that can cause me harm, including communicable disease.

2. I freely accept and fully assume all responsibility for all "Risks" and possibilities of any and all personal injury, sickness, disease, medical payments, death, property damage or loss resulting from my participation in "Equine Activities".

3. I agree that although the "Host" has taken steps to reduce the "Risks" and increase the safety of the "Equine Activities", it is not possible for the "Host" to make the "Equine Activities" completely safe. I accept these "Risks" and agree to the terms of this waiver even if the "Host" is found to be negligent or in breach of any duty of care or any obligation to me in my participation in "Equine Activities".

4. In addition to consideration given to the "Host" for my participation in "Equine Activities", I and my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and assigns (collectively my "Legal Representatives") agree:

- a) to waive all claims that I have or may have in the future against the "Host";
- b) to release and forever discharge the "Host" from all liability for any personal injury, death, property damage, or loss resulting from my participation in the equine activity due to any cause, including but not limited to negligence (failure to use such care as a reasonably prudent and careful person would use under similar circumstances), breach of any duty imposed by law, breach of contract or mistake or error in judgment of the "Host"; and
- c) to be liable for and to hold harmless and indemnify the "Host" from all actions, proceedings, claims, damages, costs demands, including court costs and costs on a solicitor and own client basis, and liabilities of whatsoever nature or kind arising out of or in any way connected with my participation in "Equine Activities".

5. I agree that this waiver and all terms contained herein are governed exclusively and in all respects by the laws of the Province or Territory of Canada in which the "Equine Activities" are provided by the "Host". I hereby irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of that Province or Territory of Canada and I agree that no other court can exercise jurisdiction over the terms and claims referred to herein. Any litigation to enforce this waiver will be instituted in the Province or Territory of Canada in which the "Equine Activities" are provided by the "Host".

6. I confirm that I have had sufficient time to read and understand this waiver in its entirety. I understand that this agreement represents the entire agreement between myself and the "Host", and it is binding on myself and my "Legal Representatives".

7. I confirm that I have reached the age of majority in the province in which I am participating in "Equine Activities" OR I am the Parent/Guardian of the Infant Participant and am executing this waiver on behalf of the Infant Participant in my capacity as Parent/Guardian and with the intent that this waiver be binding on myself and the Infant Participant for all legal purposes.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY FOR ALL CLAIMS AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

Completed waivers must be returned with registration or prior to attending the Organizer's event: Training Competition at Strathgartney Equestrian Park (the "Event"). This waiver does not affect accident and out-of-country travel insurance provided by the Organization where applicable.

By signing below, the Participant (named below) and/or the Participant's Guardian represents that the Participant:

1. Has not travelled internationally during the last 14 days;
2. Has not visited a COVID-19 high risk area, region or location in Canada during the last 14 days;
3. Does not knowingly have COVID-19;
4. Is not experiencing known symptoms of COVID-19, such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath, and if experiences such symptoms during the Event will immediately depart from the Event;
5. Has not, in the past 14 days, knowingly come into contact with someone who has COVID-19, who has known symptoms of COVID-19, or is self-quarantining after returning to Canada; and
6. Follows government recommended guidelines in respect of COVID-19, including practising physical distancing, and will do so to the best of the participant's ability during the Event.

In addition, by signing below the Participant and/or the Participant's Guardian understands, acknowledges and assumes the inherent risks in participating in the Event, including, but not limited to: the potential for bodily injury or illness (including contraction of COVID-19); contact or interaction with others who may have been exposed to COVID-19; permanent disability, paralysis, or loss of life; collision with natural or man-made objects; dangers arising from adverse weather conditions; imperfect venue or field of play conditions; equipment failure; participants of varying skill levels; inadequate safety measures; circumstances known, unknown or beyond the control of the Organizer, its partners, sponsors, agents, affiliates, directors, employees, officer, therapists, or volunteers (together, the "Organization"); negligence or omission of the Organization (collectively, the "Risks").

In consideration for allowing the Participant to participate in the Event, the Participant and/or the Participant's Guardian:

- (a) release, discharge and forever hold harmless the Organization from any and all liability for damages or loss arising as a result of the Risks of participation in or in connection with the Event;
